

Bleeding shock absorbers before installation

Before installing new shock absorbers, you must bleed them by moving the piston rod up and down several times.

Background: Due to the horizontal position of the shock absorbers, it is possible for gas and hydraulic fluid to mix inside the shock absorber (Fig. 1).

This results in the optimum absorption effect not being reached until the vehicle has been bounced up and down a few times. Apart from this, there can be increased noise (hissing).
