

Installation Guide for PTFE Seals

LP0824

The oil seal used in this oil pump is a PTFE (polytetrafluoroethylene) material oil seal. Installation of this type of seal is different to the conventional spring-loaded oil seal.

To avoid any installation errors please follow the guidance below:

1 PRE-CLEAN

The crankshaft must be cleaned prior to installation.



2 SHAFTCHECK

The crankshaft surface must be in good condition; no grooves, dents, or sharp edges.



3 DRYINSTALLATION

No oil or grease needs to be used with either the crankshaft or the seal.



4 TOOLING


BGA advise to use an installation special tool. Use it if required.



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INSTALLATIONINSTRUCTIONS

- The lip seal must be pointing inside the engine.
- Push the pump to the engine face with even pressure to ensure that the lip seal does not bend during installation.



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SETTLINGTIME

Do not start the engine for at least 4 hours after installation, as new seal lip needs time to settle before the engine can be started.
